Exceptional Federation Home on Two Blocks of Land (Circa 1921)

Kendall, originally named 'Camden Heads' as the river port of the Camden Haven River, was renamed in 1891 after the Australian poet Henry Kendall. Henry Kendall lived in the area from 1875 to 1881 when he was the first Forest Inspector for New South Wales.

This home is a magnificent example of Federation architecture originally built in 1921 by the Longworth family, who were the operators of a major sawmill within the village.

In 1956 the home was purchased by the current owner's family, and is now offered to the open market for the first time in 66 years.

Featuring wide covered verandahs, high ceilings, stained glass windows, large entry, centr...

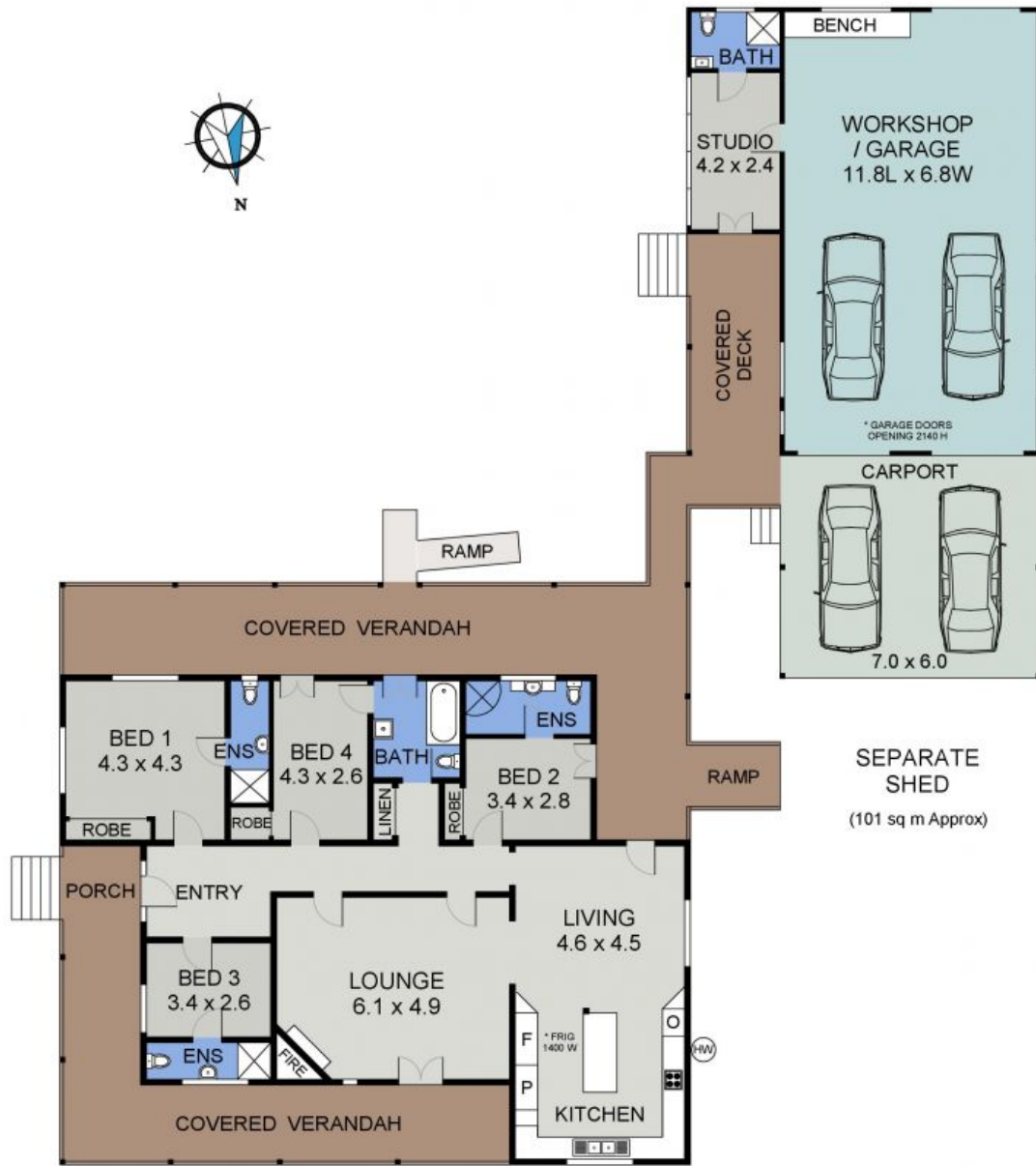
